Some examples of items that need to be packed using a vertical machine are:

- Granulated coffee
- Sugar

- Powdered milk
- Flour
- Powdered spices
- Rice
- Beans

Vertical packaging machines can also be outfitted with robot counter and feed systems, and cartooning machines, and modified with a wide range of options.

In a vertical packing machine, seal manufacture and <u>bag filling</u> occur simultaneously. The amount of time spent on any further pre-heating, heating, or cooling is determined by the time spent on a single cycle. This can end up producing a less polished appearance, which might not win your approval.

It is able to fill the product in terms of weight, volume, and individual units. Flow wrap machines, on the other hand, often have the ability to pack products that can be counted by parts.

High speed

Vertical packaging allows for accurate bag filling at a fast rate of speed per minute, making it ideal for items that are sticky or gummy like candies.

Disadvantages of Vertical Packaging Machine

It is not so fast as the horizontal packing machine

One thing about the maximum packing speed of vertical packing machines is not high as horizontal packing machines. A horizontal packing machine can pack up to 400 bags. But not vertical packing machines can pack that much. That is something you should think about when deciding which type of machine to buy.

Can't pack solid goods

A vertical packing machine cannot pack solid goods such as bread, cookies, muffin, and even masks. It is also important to think about what type of products you will be packaging. If you plan on packaging solid goods, then we suggest that you opt for a horizontal packing machine instead.

Important Considerations When Buying Horizontal and Vertical Packing Machine

When deciding between a horizontal and a vertical packaging machine, the product that the client wants to pack is the single most crucial factor to consider.

A greater variety of items may be packed with a vertical packaging machine as opposed to a horizontal packing machine.

However, the horizontal packing machine is able to reach its maximum packing speed with some items because these products have consistent forms that allow them to be numbered and filled by pieces.

In the case of the packaging of hard candy, for instance, a horizontal packing machine equipped with a candy feeder is capable of running even more than 400 bags per minute, but a vertical packing machine is unable to achieve such a rate.
